



Clinical research and teaching are vital for medicine. It's costly but necessary if we're to offer top-notch medical care.


Hôpital Charles-Le Moyne contributes to building solid foundations for the advancement of medical knowledge. Did you know that:

The goal of the Pikorua project is to **create a state-of-the-art microbiology and social sciences research laboratory.** The research will focus on the microbiological and social factors that cause the spread of antibiotic-resistant bacteria, a major concern the world over.

While it's important to limit the use of antibiotics, Dr. Haraoui's researchers are seeking to identify other less obvious factors that will make it possible to improve our capacity to contain the spread of these bacteria.




At the request of the team of orthopaedic surgeons at Hôpital Charles-Le Moyne, the Foundation committed to funding the purchase of an **orthopaedic surgical robot**. This will give patients waiting for a knee replacement access to the most advanced technology available today.

In Québec, 30,000 patients are waiting in pain for a prosthesis to change their lives—9,000 of them have been waiting for more than a year. Knee replacements using conventional methods are an imperfect solution. The new robot offers more precise and tailored surgery so that patients can resume normal lives.


